## JW - SVALBARD

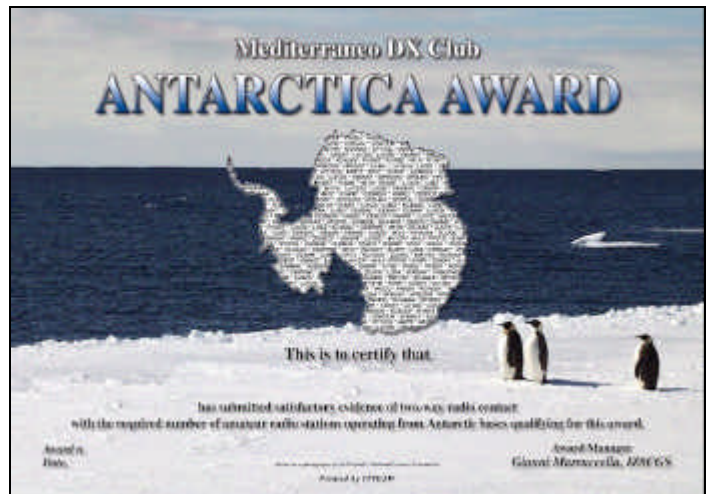

## LOTW NEWS

To all Logbook of the World certificate holders -

All LoTW certificates currently have a term of one year and must be renewed before expiration. No additional documentation will be required if the renewal request is created before the certificate expires.

We will send an email reminder to all certificate holders whose certificates are about to expire. This email will refer users to detailed renewal instructions on the Logbook of the World Web site ([www.arrl.org/lotw/renew](http://www.arrl.org/lotw/renew)).



The Mediterraneo DX Club (<http://www.mdx.org>) issues the *Antarctica Award* (<http://www.mdx.org/antarctica/>) for contacting amateur radio stations operating from the various human settlements ("bases") in Antarctica, defined as the area south of 60° South latitude, including islands and ice shelves, to which the provisions of the Antarctic Treaty apply.

The *Antarctica Award* is available to either licensed amateurs or SWLs.

All contacts must have taken place since 1 January 1961.

Contacts may be made on any amateur radio HF band from 10 to 160 metres, on CW, SSB and RTTY (neither single band nor single mode endorsements will be issued).

The **Basic Award** is issued for confirmed contacts with 5 different bases located in at least 3 of the 7 sectors into which the Antarctic territory has been divided up for the purposes of this Award.

The fees for the Basic Award are EUR 15,00 or USD 15,00 (EUR 12,00 or USD 12,00 for MDXC members), P&P included.

The IOTA net meets on 14260 kHz at 1300 UTC on Saturdays and on 21260 at 1300 UTC on Sundays. The following frequencies are considered as the meeting place for Island chasers: CW - 28040, 24920, 21040, 18098, 14040, 10114, 7030 and 3530 kHz; SSB - 28560, 28460, 24950, 21260, 18128, 14260, 7055 and 3765 kHz.

- ◆ **AF-019 - LAMPEDUSA ISL:** Gianni, IZ8CGS will be active here Sept 23-26. QSL via IK8VRN.
- ◆ **AS-024 - IRIOMOTE-YAEYAMA ISLANDS (JA6):** Steve, K7USJ will be active as 7J1AIL/JR6 September 29 - October 2. Activity will be on 40-6 meters, CW/SSB + FM on 29.30. QSL to K7USJ direct or to 7J1AIL direct or via the JARL bureau.

Roger Barker, G4IDE has become a Silent Key. Roger's software for APRS, UI-View, has been a significant contribution to our hobby. He has been a recipient of the TAPR Lifetime Achievement Award, a portion of the text is cited below.

#### TAPR Lifetime Achievement Award - Roger Barker G4IDE

TAPR is pleased to award a Lifetime Achievement Award to Roger Barker G4IDE, of Lincolnshire, UK.

Roger has worked tirelessly for many years to provide quality software for Amateur Radio operators, allowing them to operate advanced digital modes without the difficulties once associated with these operations.

The UI-View software is the benchmark by which all other APRS Raster Mapping software is compared to.

Whilst writing excellent software, Roger has also ensured that users are able to experiment with his software by allowing access to the internal features of his software through an extensive API. Once the software was written, he ensured that the software was extensively supported, starting mailing lists to support his software. To date one of these lists has had 35,000 messages, with Roger reading each one and replying to a significant number of them.

These are just some of the reasons that TAPR is proud to present a Lifetime Achievement Award to Roger Barker, G4IDE, for his services to Digital Communications"

As part of his final legacy, Roger has made his UI-View32 software free to hams. Registration is still required, but fellow hams have volunteered to take on the task. See <http://welcome.to/uiview> for details. His hard work and friendly demeanor will be missed.

- ◆ **DU9/NØNM - PHILIPPINES -160:** Jon is preparing for the coming low band "season". He has restrung an Inverted L and added some radials and has "rotated" the tubes in his amplifier. Look for Jon after his sunset daily around 1828.3.
- ◆ **FP/NN9K - ST PIERRE-MIQUELON:** Pete will be active until September 18th. He was running a pileup for a long time Monday morning on 17 meter CW. QSL via home call.
- ◆ **HFØQF - SOUTH SHETLANDS:** Voytek will be active from the Polish base "Henryk Arctowski" on King George Island for the next year. He will be operating CW/SSB from 80 to 10 meters although he seems to prefer 7056 and 3513. QSL via SP7IWA.
- ◆ **KH9/K7ASU - WAKE ISLAND:** Terry is back on Wake Island and will be there for several weeks. His operating time is limited by 12 hour workdays but look for him on 14018, 14182, 14070, 7018, 7182 and 10118. He's running 100 watts with an R7 vertical antenna.... No antennas for 160, 80 or 6 meters. QSL via home call.
- ◆ **KP1 and KP5:** Efforts are still being made to gain access to these two locations. Unfortunately, the US Fish & Wildlife Service has denied the latest request, citing "illegal drug and illegal immigration activity, their inability to ensure the operators safety and the difficulty of making a safe landing." The effort to gain permission will continue.
- ◆ **S79MH - SEYCHELLES:** Marco, HB9OCR will be active from Praslin Island October 26-November 6. He will operate all HF bands except 80. QSL via HB9OCR.
- ◆ **ST2T - SUDAN:** Dane will remain in country for 2 or 3 months. He was very active in the WAE contest over the weekend on 15 and 10 SSB. QSL via S57DX.
- ◆ **TA3 - TURKEY:** Dennis, DL7RBI will be spending his holidays at Ephesus September 18-October 1. He will be signing TA3/ homecall or TA3Z if he can get a "guest" license. Operation will be mostly in the evenings (local) on 40-10 CW with SSB upon request. QSL via home call.
- ◆ **TC2K4J - TURKEY:** Berkin, TA3J will use this special call from Antalya, in memory of the 40 Silent Keys of Turkish Radio Amateurs from 0240, Spetember 24 to 0240Z November 2. - ◆ **XU7TZG - CAMBODIA:** Wim, ON6TZ will be active from Sihanoukville until September 28. He was supposed to be active on 40, 20 and 15, but he was reported over the weekend on 17 meter CW/SSB. QSL via ON6TZ.
- ◆ **ZD8I - ASCENSION:** Ian, G8WVW will be active on 80-6 meters SSB until June of 2006. QSLs should go via G4TLI.
- ◆ **ZK3DX - TOKELAU:** Dennis has been quite active on several bands SSB. QSL via EB2AYV.
